

Intermediate/Advanced Watercolor supply list

Susan Grogan

Pallet with lid and mixing tray

Large water container

Drawing pencils: 2H and HB, kneaded eraser

Canson brand, tracing paper 9 x 12"

Paper towels

Masking tape

Board to mount watercolor paper...gator board, foam board, or Masonite

Sketch paper

Graphite paper- (X-Press It Transfer paper, graphite) brand, works well to transfer drawings

Inexpensive pad of watercolor paper

140lb Arches rough watercolor paper

Paints: you may use whatever you have. You do not need to have all the colors I use.

I recommend professional grade tube watercolors. Da Vinci, Daniel Smith, American Journey, Winsor Newton, etc....These are the colors ones I use most often, but you can always use what you have...

New Gamboge

Quin Gold

Aureolin

Burnt Sienna

Yellow Ochre

Joe's Red (American Journey)

Burnt Umber

Cobalt Blue

Permanent Alizarin Crimson

Phthalo Blue

Ultramarine Blue

Mauve (Da Vinci)

Phthalo Green

Aussie Red Gold (Daniel smith)

Brushes: any watercolor brushes you have will do. I mostly use #1 liner, 12" round, flat wash brush 1" or 1 1/2", various flat brushes for lifting.
