

Summer Art Camp 2024 Scholarship Application

Each year, Mount Dora Center for the Arts provides tuition assistance to selected students who are INTERESTED IN ART but may be unable to take advantage of MDCA Art Camp programs due to financial restrictions. Scholarships are generally granted for a one week session per child and are based on financial need, fund availability and the student's motivation to learn about art. Applications are reviewed by a selection committee at MDCA.

Eligibility: Applicants must be residents of Lake County and be between the ages of 6 to 12. Scholarships are available to public, private and home schooled students.

Youth Scholarship applicants must include:

- The Scholarship Application
- A letter of recommendation from the student's Art or Academic Teacher, Guidance Counselor or Principal.
- Proof of any financial assistance such as Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is helpful

Completed applications must be received no later than **May 5, 2024**. Applicants will be notified by May 13, 2024 via email. One application per eligible student.
