Pallet with lid and mixing tray

Large water container

Drawing pencils: 2H and HB, kneaded eraser

Paper towels

Masking tape

Board to mount watercolor paper...gator board, foam board, or Masonite

Sketch paper or Sketch pad

Graphite paper- (X-Press It Transfer paper, graphite) brand, works well to transfer your drawings

300lb Arches cold press watercolor paper Paints: you may use whatever you have. You do not need to have all the colors I use.

I recommend professional grade tube watercolors. Daniel Smith, Mission, Winsor Newton, etc....These are the colors ones I use most often, but you can always use what you have...

New Gamboge - Aureolin - Yellow Ochre - Permanent Alizarin Crimson - Ultramarine Blue

Cobalt Blue - Phthalo Green - Quin Gold - Burnt Sienna - Permanent Rose

Cobalt Blue P - Phthalo Blue - Mineral Violet

Brushes: any watercolor brushes you have will do. I mostly use #1 liner, 6" or 8" round brush, 12" round, flat wash brush 1" or $1 \frac{1}{2}$, various flat brushes for lifting.
